HIVE has been at the forefront of innovating comprehensive HIV-informed sexual and reproductive health care since 1989. A team of compassionate experts, HIVE provides clinical care, training, advocacy and a virtual hub for disseminating best practices.

HIVE Mission: Advancing reproductive and sexual wellness for individuals, families and communities affected by HIV in San Francisco and beyond.

HIVE Vision: A world where people affected by HIV have safe pregnancies, reproductive autonomy, access to state-of-the-art health care, and enjoyable sex lives.

HIVE Clinic: Based at Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital, HIVE Clinic provides multidisciplinary preconception, prenatal, gynecologic and sexual health care to women living with HIV as well as HIV-affected couples. **Clinical care includes:** outpatient/inpatient high-risk obstetrics, obstetric-specific psychiatric care, prenatal nutrition and health education, inpatient nursery care, comprehensive social services, and partner HIV testing and linkage to care.

HIVE Training: HIVE providers offer trainings worldwide. We hold leadership positions in multiple workgroups, including the National Perinatal HIV Hotline, Elimination of Mother-to-Child HIV Transmission Stakeholders Group, Expert Panel on Reproductive Health for Women and Men living with HIV, and US Women and PrEP Working Group. We work in close collaboration with and contribute to guidelines and policy created by DHHS Adult Antiretroviral Guidelines, DHHS Perinatal Antiretroviral Guidelines, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the World Health Organization.

HIVE Advocacy: With a commitment to ending HIV transmission, we advocate for programming to sustain the success of perinatal HIV prevention; increased access to primary HIV prevention for trans and non-trans women; a comprehensive HIV prevention toolkit including family planning and empowered sexuality; the inclusion of reproductive and sexual health in the primary care setting; safer conception options for HIV-affected couples and reproductive health care for men.
